They are about 3 hours away from each other. She was told to pack all of her belongings and bring them with her to court, which we take as a good sign she will be released!

Zalix’s father Doug was in attendance at our mother’s day service! My message was from 1 Samuel 1 and was about the example Hannah showed in being a Godly woman/mother. Later that night I got a text from Doug and he said he had just got off the phone with his wife and he told her he went to church and then she asked what my message was about. When he told her, she said that was the same scripture that her chapel service was on! Doug told me thank you and that he knew that was a sign from God, and his faith was strengthened!

Starting next week, we can begin holding our coach’s Bible study in person again! We have 2 new coaches on the coaching staff this year, and both have said they would love to attend the Bible study! I have been in communication with the coaches also throughout the quarantine and they are all super excited to start holding the Bible study again. Most have even said this last few months has caused them to reevaluate and prioritize what is important in life! Because of this I believe we can do a deeper dive into scripture and hopefully see tremendous growth and revival!

Also, as I had mentioned in my last report, keep my childhood friend Warren E. in your prayers concerning salvation. I have talked to him several times and I believe he is very close to accepting Christ. He was raised Catholic, and still has a skewed conception of salvation and scripture but he is willing to listen. I am hoping to be able to visit him whenever I return home to see my mother in the near future.
