Summer Ministry

We started the month of June with a trip visiting family and friends in Texas and Louisiana. As always, it was a privilege spending a Sunday morning with my mother and the great folks of Stockwell MBC in Bossier City, LA and Sunday night with our sending church, Eastside MBC in Minden, LA. We enjoyed much needed fellowship in both places and enjoyed sharing briefly the work that God is doing here in Colorado.

As I stated in the last newsletter the last few months of ministry have been everything but normal! Finding new ways to interact with the community and how to hold church services were and still are major issues here.

As far as church services go, we were encouraged that my son's friend's father had been attending several Sunday services in a row, but the last week of May, he got a call from his family in Illinois that his father has cancer and his life expectancy is 6 months or less. Because of this, he decided to go spend time with his dad. I have spoken to him a few times and he assures me he will be back in a few days and is looking forward to being with us again on Sunday mornings. This is the same family I have been asking prayers for because of the mother being in Jail. She is scheduled to have her court hearing on July 13 and if all goes as planned, she will be released! I have spoken to her several times also and she indicated that she is excited about attending our Sunday services together as a family when she gets released.

Praise the Lord, the Colorado athletic association has allowed school sports to start back with limited activity! That means I can finally be around the boys on the football team again! This is a huge part of my ministry that has literally been cut off from me for the last 4 months. Due to everything that has happened in the world, I know they will have lots of questions for me and I cannot wait to be an encouragement and mentor to them. There are many life issues I will be counseling them on as well as being their coach. This will all be conducted with the end goal being able to get to an eternal life changing conversation about the love and grace offered by God through his son Jesus Christ.

I firmly believe that in the coming days, months and years we will become more keenly aware of just how much of a toll the past few months has exacted on our youth in America. Fear, hopelessness, depression and even suicides will be and already are on the rise as a direct result. Please continue to pray God uses me and my family to be a positive influence and a safe and inviting place for the youth to shelter from the world and hear and be taught about the love of God

Please be in prayer for a family that I have been talking to for some time now concerning church and spiritual matters. Their daughter and my daughter play competitive basketball together and have become quite good friends. A few days before we left for our trip, I received a call from the dad saying his daughter had taken a bunch of pills to end her life but thankfully, she got scared enough to run downstairs and tell her parent what she had done before it was too late. She was airlifted to Children's hospital in Denver and received medical and psychiatric treatment for several weeks and is now home! I have been in regular contact with her and the family through this difficult time and have had some very productive Gospel conversations with them. The father and one daughter have made professions of faith but have never been baptized or joined a church. The mother and the other daughter have so far never made a profession. Please lift this family up in prayers for comfort and healing and me as I move beyond the temporary difficult situation and move to a more eternal focus with them.

How can you help?

- Please pray that the upcoming football season is not cancelled.
I know when we are able to meet again a lot of the kids will have very deep serious questions!
- We are still in need of churches to partner with us financially for our salary fund.
